

Bible Reading Track Resources

There are numerous Bible reading tracks to be found on the Internet. But in case if you are not aware of some of the better ones, here are some links and brief descriptions. The one piece of advice I would offer is to not worry about catching up if you miss a day. The goal is to keep reading the Bible for enjoyment and spiritual growth and not to check a box off every day.

Web Links:

www.biblegateway.com – This is an excellent resource that I have used for years. Click on their tab for (reading plans) and you can further select what format (OT/NT; Chronological; Beginning; Historical; Bible in 90 Days) and you can select which version of the Bible you want.

www.ewordtoday.com – This provides multiple versions of the Bible and various formats to reading the Bible. Furthermore, there are many commentaries you can consult for a given reading.

www.bibleplan.org - The 19th Century Scottish minister, Robert Murray M'Cheyne, (sometimes spelled McCheyne) who lived from 1813-1843, prepared a plan for Bible reading to take readers through the New Testament and Psalms twice a year, and through the rest of the Bible once each year.

Book Resources (available at www.christianbook.com):

For The Love of God by Dr. D. A. Carson – This two volume set will take you through the entire Bible and the New Testament and Psalms twice. Each daily reading includes a single-page devotional thought from Carson. Carson is a pastor's son and one of the premiere Bible scholars of our day.

Through The Bible In A Year by John Stott – These daily readings take you through the Scriptures with an emphasis on both the "big picture" of the story of God and the nature of God as Trinity. Stott's unique devotional features three sections that follow the church calendar. From September to December, he focuses on how God is revealed in Old Testament times; January through Pentecost, the life of Christ in the Gospels; and May through August, the Holy Spirit in the New Testament. Christians seeking a stronger, holistic grasp on the Bible will treasure this work that overflows with wisdom gleaned from a life of study and reflection by an internationally beloved pastor and scholar.
